In November we were able to upgrade our department's radios. The Province of N.S. is funding and has contractors hired to install the new TMR 2. The **Trunked Mobile Radio** is a current and digital portable radio system that is used by most of the public safety agencies in the province. They include RCMP, EHS, Transportation & Infrastructure, Natural Resources, and the provinces **Volunteer Fire Departments** and others. This quality system allows us to communicate easily with our dispatcher, other departments, and almost all other public safety agencies, anywhere in the province, that we might need to communicate with.
