United Communities Fire Department Education Fund

The United Communities Fire Department has implemented our new education initiative. This yearly \$500 fund is designed to encourage the youth of our community to become more involved in their community and to assist students within the United Communities with the costs associated with post-secondary schooling.

Applications must be submitted to the United Communities Fire Department prior to the end of March each year.

Application must include:

- Name
- Address
- Phone Number
- Post-Secondary institute you are attending
- Capacity you performed while volunteering at UCFD

Each applicant must:

- live within the United Communities
- be accepted to a post-secondary schooling
- cannot be a recipient of the fund a second time
- volunteer with the United Communities Fire Department (minimum 20 hrs annually)

If multiple applicants are received the Fire Department will select one applicant each year to receive the fund. If you are not a successful applicant, you are able to apply in subsequent years providing you are still attending a post-secondary institution. More information about this fund will be published in the "SIREN" by March 1st.

DANGEROUS MATERIALS IN OUR COMMUNITY

As a general safety measure within our communities we, as your volunteer fire department emergency responders, ask you to ensure that any dangerous materials you may have, either in buildings or on your property, are stored in the appropriate containers, properly licensed if required, with proper signage posted or any other common sense measures taken to mitigate any possible hazard to emergency responders (fire, EHS, police) or neighbours. These dangerous materials may include but not limited to large volumes of gas / diesel, propane tanks, other compressed gas cylinders, explosives / blasting caps, toxic / corrosive liquids, large volumes of paint or ammunition, etc.
