During each of our emergency call outs, personnel are needed to fulfil a number of jobs including Breathing Apparatus use, operating the pumper truck, refilling the tanker truck, traffic control and many other small but equally important jobs. Not many of these jobs require physical exertion. With this said I would encourage you to come out and see what we do and get a feel for the important part you can play in your local Fire Department.

Your bunker gear and forestry gear is provided.

There are Provincial benefits- Car/truck Registration free after 1 year of service that includes a minimum hours per year of volunteer time. This time includes all practices, training courses, call outs attended, fund-raising events etc.

Provincial and federal tax relief again with a commitment of hours per year of volunteer time toward the functioning of the fire department.

The fire department will pay for First aid, MFR, Level 1 FF and other pertinent training.

You are also eligible for Personal Insurance Benefits after initial training and hours per year of volunteering time.

And the pride you get from serving your community is free for the taking.

The United Communities meets at 6:30 pm on the first 4 Mondays of every month. The first Monday is a meeting, next two are practice and the 4th if for maintenance.
