**Burning Restrictions:** We are in the burn ban season and to this point the majority of burning has only been allowed from 7pm to 8 am. When there are no restrictions you can burn from 2 pm until 8 am. When the burning ban is red, that indicates no fires including fire pits, chiminea. Please have proper extinguishing materials on hand while burning and take the wind into consideration if you are going to burn. Thank you all for following the guidelines and keeping our communities safe.
